

Court Fees - automatic sharing of costs

You can share the costs of your indoor, padel or floodlit booking automatically with the other players on your booking.

How it works...

When booking the court, the person booking the court will always be charged the full amount at the time of booking. However, they can get their share of the fees from the other players named on the booking by following the steps below.

- when making the indoor booking, ensure that the fee sharing box remains ticked (it is ticked by default)
- add the other member/s to the booking (note that you should add all the players - if you only added two other players, the costs would be split 3 ways, not by 4)

On the day of the booking...

- ensure that you and the other named players on the booking check in before going on court, using the card reader in the reception lobby
- once another player has checked in using the card reader, their account will be deducted by their share of the cost and the booker's account will be credited.

NOTE - Cost sharing will only occur if the named players have sufficient funds on their member account at the time of "swiping in".

Please also note that if you **don't want** the automatic fee sharing applied - you should just untick the fee sharing box when making your booking.

(Note that the other players will need to have ticked the relevant GDPR boxes on "my consent" in their website account. If they haven't given consent, their name will not come up when you type their surname. Please let reception know if their name is not coming up so that we can help them update their consents.)
